



## SBA List Fact Sheet:

### Planned Parenthood's 2015-2016 Annual Report – Five Years at a Glance<sup>1</sup>

- **Taxpayer funding accounted for 41%** of Planned Parenthood's overall revenue in fiscal year 2015-2016.<sup>2</sup>
- In FY 2011-2012, Planned Parenthood reported receiving **\$542 million in taxpayer funding** in the form of government grants, contracts, and Medicaid reimbursements. By FY 2015-2016, Planned Parenthood's taxpayer funding increased to **\$554 million or more than \$1.5 million per day.**<sup>3</sup>

In the five years between 2011 and 2016:

- Planned Parenthood's total services are **down nearly 13%**.<sup>4</sup>
- Unique patients have **dropped by 600,000 – a 20% decline.**<sup>5</sup>
- Total cancer screening and prevention services, breast exams, and pap tests **all dropped by nearly 50%**.<sup>6</sup>
- Contraceptive services are **down 18%**.<sup>7</sup>
- STI/STD prevention and treatment services are **down nearly 5%**.<sup>8</sup>
- Abortions have remained stable. Planned Parenthood performed **328,348 abortions in 2015-2016**<sup>9</sup> and has performed **more than 1.6 million abortions in the past five years.**<sup>10</sup>
- Planned Parenthood performed approximately **145 abortions (1,641,130) for every one adoption referral (11,290).**<sup>10</sup>
