

Fact Sheet: Planned Parenthood's 2016-2017 Annual Report¹

Planned Parenthood's Financials

- During fiscal year 2016-17, Planned Parenthood reported a <u>record income of \$1.46 billion.</u>²
 - Nearly \$533 million came from private contributions.³
 - Nearly \$544 million in taxpayer funding, or nearly \$1.5 million per day⁴ came in the form of government grants, contracts, and Medicaid reimbursements 37% of Planned Parenthood's overall revenue.⁵
 - o Planned Parenthood reported **\$98.5 million in excess revenue** and **more than \$1.6 billion in net assets**.

Abortions and Non-Abortion Services: Change from Last Year and Long-Term Trends

- Planned Parenthood <u>performed 321,384 abortions</u>⁷ in 2016 and <u>more than 1.6 million abortions</u> (1,628,550)⁸ over the past five reported years (2012-2017).
- In 2016, <u>abortions made up 96% of Planned Parenthood's pregnancy resolution services</u>, while prenatal services, miscarriage care, and adoption referrals accounted for only 2.3% (7,762), 0.4% (1,182) and 1.2% (3,889), respectively.⁹
- Prenatal services <u>dropped nearly 18% in 2016</u> and <u>more than 60% over the past five reported years</u>.
- For every adoption referral in 2016, Planned Parenthood performed more than 82 abortions. 11 Over the past five reported years, the ratio was approx. 126 abortions for every adoption referral. 12
- According to the last five years of data from Planned Parenthood's own annual reports¹³:
 - o Total services are down nearly 13%.
 - Total cancer screening and prevention services have dropped by more than 41%, including declines of approximately 39% for breast exams and 43% for pap tests.
 - o Contraceptive services are down nearly 28%.
 - Unique patients have **dropped by 600,000 a 20% decline**.
 - o Approximately 100 (14%) of Planned Parenthood facilities have closed their doors.
